## Fill My Freezer & Save Tax \$

Purchase animal and take possession for consumption., cut to your specifications!

### Example:

110 lb. lamb

Your bid \$5.00/lb.

110 lb X \$5.00=\$550.00

Your bid \$550.00

Exhibitor receives \$550.00

Cost to you \$550.00

Buyer responsible for butcher cost. You can pickup the animal or a sale volunteer will haul it to the local butcher options for you.

A list of processing partners will be available closer to the sale or contact your processor of choice to reserve your spot.

## Save Me Tax \$\$\$

If you desire not to keep the animal, you pay the difference between the full bid price and a turn buyer market value.

### Example:

Market value of 110 lb. lamb

110 lb X \$1.00 =\$110.00

Your bid \$5.00/lb. x 110 lb = \$550.00

You pay the difference:

Your bid \$550.00

Exhibitor receives \$550.00

Market value -\$110.00

Cost to you \$440.00

**Note: Buyer does not take meat for their use**

## Save Me Time

Pool dollars—Flat dollar amount. A committee member will combine your money with other pool dollars to buy animals at the auction. Your name will be mentioned with other pool bidders as winning bidders on animal.

### Example:

Pool dollars \$200.00 + 350.00

Exhibitor receives \$200.00 + 350.00

Cost to you \$200.00

**Note: Buyer does not take meat for their use**

## Important Tips

- Add-on contribution forms are to be completed at the Market Sale and can be turned into our clerk table with payment.
- Consider buying an animal for your employees or a giving it away as charity.
- **Businesses:** Please consult your tax accountant for ways to expense your cost from your business taxes.



## 2024 Junior Livestock Show Market Sale Protocol:

The day of the sale, buyers will be required to register as a bidder and a number will be provided.

As each animal is brought into the ring, the auctioneer will ask for bids, on a per pound basis. If you wish to bid on an animal, raise your buyer number to signal your bid. The highest bidder buys the animal.

**The Junior Livestock Show requests that animals be paid for at the time of purchase at the Clerk table.**
