Also, include at least two; and no more than four letters of recommendation from 4-H leaders, FFA Advisors, School Counselor, teacher, coach, etc.

Up to five scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$2,000. The scoring rubric is available upon request.

Applications must be submitted to the Junior Livestock Show office no later than April 10, of the current year.
